COMPETITION: The competition will be run in the new Churchill Arena in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026 (please check for eligibility).

Each team will consist of 3 or 4 members with 3 scores to count. All members of each team will jump consecutively. No pony can compete more than once in the same class.

ENTRIES will be taken on a first come, first served basis with branches able to enter up to TWO teams in each class. We will also accept mixed teams - teams made up of individual members of different branches **from the same Area** but only if a branch is not fielding a team in the class.

Entries close with final declaration of team members on Sunday 12th September 2026. Entries will close earlier if classes are full.

A wait list will be taken, if oversubscribed at entry point, and those successful will be notified if a place becomes available.

If the competition is undersubscribed a PC80 Teams class will be added on August 31st so, please make sure you make your entries before this date. Anyone competing in the PC100 or PC90 classes will not be eligible for this additional class.

WARM UP Teams will not be allowed into the warm up arena until 10 minutes before the start time of their first rider.

PRIZES Prizes for the 1st placed teams & rosettes for 1st – 6th teams. Completion rosettes for all unplaced competitors.

Prize giving will be mounted for the winning team. 2nd - 6th placed teams will be on foot for prize giving but dressed in appropriate attire. Prize giving will take place in the arena as soon as possible after the competition has finished. Please monitor the live scoreboard (on Pony Club Results) to ensure that you are ready in good time. Completion rosettes can be collected from the secretary's tent for all teams placed 7th and below.

NUMBERS Please print your own numbers to be worn in a number bib. You can click on your name in Pony Club Results to obtain a printable version. Numbers to be printed/written as large as possible in dark ink please. **Please do NOT use bridle numbers.**

REFUNDS No refund of entry fees will be made after the **closing date** of entries.

PASSES 1 horsebox pass and 2 admission tickets will be issued to each competitor by email. 1 x DC and 1 x Team Trainer will also be issued with admission passes. All other spectators will have to pay to access the main arena/trade stands area except for children under 12yr.

SUBSTITUTIONS After the closing date no substitutions may be made of horses or riders except in cases of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances which must be certified by the District Commissioner or their appointed Representative.

PARKING It would be very helpful if competitors could double up and travel together where possible as parking is limited. Please follow instructions given by the Parking Stewards at all times.

GENERAL Please note that the Churchill Arena and lorry park is located in the middle of the Blenheim Horse Trials cross country course and therefore please ensure that the ponies and horses entered for the competition are suitable for this setting. Also extra care must be taken at XC crossing points entering and accessing the lorry park.

Passports must be available on request, and spot checks may be carried out. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rule.

EVENT SITE RULES:

- The Blenheim Estate is a World Heritage site, please respect this.
- All dogs must be always kept on leads and under control and please clean up after your dog.
- Please take your rubbish home.
- Please bring an extra printed bib number (competition number) for each competitor which is to be left clearly visible in the windscreen of the competitor's lorry/trailer whilst on site.
- No horses may be left unattended outside of lorries/trailers.
- No hay nets may be used or tied to the outside of lorries/trailers.
- All droppings must be removed from the lorry park immediately.
- When mounted, all competitors must use designated horse walks and crossing points. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

- No person or horse under any circumstances should use the FEI hacking track, and if found doing so may be subject to the penalty of Team Elimination immediately.
- Abuse of stewards, officials, volunteers, and fellow competitors will not be tolerated.
